ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING SERVICES, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the follow mg articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendment(s) adopted:

ARTICLE X

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.)

ARTICLE XI

No part of the net earnings of the corporations shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its member, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 (c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing of distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.)

ARTICLE XII

Upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment(s) was: June 24, 1999.
