A NONCORPORATION

I / ARAJ. FISHEL, the undersigned natural person of the age of
eighteen years or older, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a
noncorporation under the laws of the State of Florion as
contained in 6/7 (STATUE) entitled
"NonCorporation Act," and the general amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:
