The undersigned incorporators, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following the following Articles of Incorporation.

**Article I. Name**

The name of the corporation shall be UNITED CHURCH BUILDERS, INC.

**Article II. Principal Office**

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 3610 Shamrock West, Tallahassee, Florida 32312.

**Article III. Purpose**

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- a. To buy, sell, build, rent, lease, sub-lease real and personal property.
- b. To buy and sell disposable property such as food, clothing, household items, automobiles and any other titled vehicles.
- c. To perform any other act authorized by law and not inconsistent with the provisions of Chapter 617, FLORIDA STATUTES.

**Articles IV. Manner of Election of Directors**

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is by vote of the officers of the corporation. There should be five directors, three of whom shall be officers and two of whom may be clergy. The manner of election or appointment of directors and number of directors may be changed by the by-laws of this corporation.

**Article V. Initial Registered Agent**

The initial Registered Agent and the street address of the initial Registered Agent of this corporation is: John D. Carlson, 501 E. Tennessee Street, Suite B, Tallahassee, FL 32308. The Board of Directors from time to time may move the Registered Office to any other address in the State of Florida and may change the Registered Agent

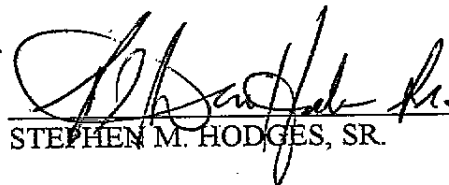

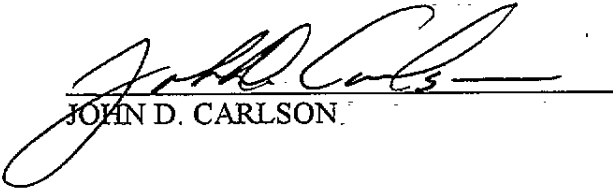
