Purpose(s)

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

ARTICLE IV

Manner of election of directors.

ARTICLE V

Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited as follows:

Institute of Theological Education, Inc., is to have the power to do any and all things necessary or expedient for carrying out the purposes of this corporation, and in general to possess all rights, privileges and immunities, and to enjoy all the benefits granted to corporations of similar characters under the laws of the State of Florida. These powers shall include, but not be limited to:

- 1. Erect, purchase, enter into a lease agreement, and maintain and upgrade, church buildings, social halls, business offices, and such other structures deemed necessary to carry out the overall purposes of this corporation.
- 2. Collect, solicit, and accept funds, gifts and other subscriptions necessary to purchase, lease and maintain all facilities used for the stated purposes of this corporation as a nonprofit organization.
- 3. Conduct all other powers necessary to carry out the general and specific purposes of the corporation.
