*Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.*

A. In order to accomplish the purposes and to attain the objectives for which this Corporation is formed and for which the funds and property of this Corporation shall be handled, administered, operated and distributed, the Corporation, its Officers and Directors, shall possess and exercise all powers, authorities and privileges granted by and under the laws of the State of Florida not inconsistent with the requirements for exemption under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and (page 2)

Treasury Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

C. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal state, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
