

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida Not For Profit Corporation adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation has been changed to Community Pet Rescue Inc.

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the objects and purpose of this Corporation shall be to reduce the homeless dog and cat population in Miami-Dade County through educational, spay/neuter, and adoption programs. Additionally, to manage community cat populations through trap-neuter-release-manage [TNRM] programs.

The Corporation may contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers or corporate property or instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness.

To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of capital stock of, any bonds, securities, or other evidence of indebtedness created by any corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while the owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
