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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
GOOD NEWS BAPTIST CHURCH OF PINE MANOR, INC.  
(A Corporation Not for Profit)

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a corporation for charitable and philanthropic purposes, under the provisions of Section 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is Good News Baptist Church of Pine Manor, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the objectives and purposes of this corporation shall be:

- To bring Glory to God.
- a) To bring others to Jesus Christ.
- b) Baptizing believers into our fellowship.
- c) Grow in understanding of God's Word.
- d) Teach believers to minister to others.
- e) Gloffy God with Prayer, Praise, and Worship.

ARTICLE III

The membership of this corporation shall constitute all persons hereinafter named as subscribers and such other persons as from time to time hereafter, may become members, in the manner provided in the bylaws.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VI

Section 1: The officers of the corporation shall be a Moderator, Vice-Moderators, Clerk, Treasurer, and such other officers as provided in the bylaws.

Section 2: The names of the persons who are to serve as officers of the corporation until the first meeting of the Board of Directors are:

#### ARTICLE VIII

Section 1: The Board of Directors of this corporation may provide such bylaws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes as they may deem necessary from time to time.

Section 2: Upon proper notice the bylaws may be amended, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of those members of the Board of Directors present at any regular meeting or any special meeting called for that purpose.

#### ARTICLE IX

Section 1: These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at a special meeting of the membership called for that purpose, by a majority vote of those present.

Section 2: Amendments may also be made at a regular meeting of the membership upon notice given, as provided in the bylaws, of intention to submit such amendments.

#### ARTICLE X

The location of the corporation shall be at 1650 Oak Drive, Fort Myers, FL 33907.

#### ARTICLE XI

Section 1: No part of the net earning of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons.

#### ARTICLE XII

To take, secure, hold or acquire, by gift, purchase, legacy or otherwise, real and personal property, whenever it may deem the same proper, necessary and expedient in the work and purpose of the organization and incorporation of this body; to hold, lease, encumber, give, exchange or sell and transfer and dispose of the same, in part or in whole, when it deems such an action expedient, necessary or beneficial in promoting and advancing the work and purposes of this organization; and to do and accomplish such acts as this body shall deem necessary or incidental thereto, all such acts to conform to the laws of this state.

#### ARTICLE XIII

Section 1: The annual meeting for the election of members of the Board of Directors shall be held as may be provided in the bylaws.

Section 2: The corporation may provide in its bylaws for the holding of additional regular meetings and any special meetings and shall provide notice of all such meetings.

Section 3: A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for holding of any meetings.

#### ARTICLE XIV

No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertaking of this corporation and upon dissolution of the corporation, the board shall, after paying and making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational and religious purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law) as the board shall determine.
