## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

# The Interfaith Alliance of Brevard County, Inc.

(a corporation not for profit incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida)

The undersigned incorporators, all of whom are citizens of the State of Florida and are at least twenty-one (21) years of age, acting on the instruction of the membership meeting on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January 1999 at 7:00 P.M., for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: The Interfaith Alliance of Brevard County, Inc.

#### ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address ofg this corporation shall be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors. The initial place of business and mailing address shall be 2185 Meadowland Avenue, West Melbourne, FL 32904.

#### ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The Interfaith Alliance of Brevard County, Inc. is a non-partisan, interfaith organization. The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, cultutal and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code). The corporation may engage in all activities incidental to or in furtherance of those purposes, except as restricted herein, and shall comply with the laws, rules and regulations set forth in and promulgated pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code and applicable to organizations described in section 501 (c) (3), to which contributions are deductible under section 170 (c) (2), thereof. To the extent required by section 508 (e) (1) of the Code, the corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time(s) and in such manner(s) as not to become subject to tax on undistributed income imposed by section 4942 of the Code. The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. Promoting the positive role of religion as a healing and constructive force in public life;
  - B. Challenging those who manipulate and distort religion to advance an extreme po-
