AMENDMENT TO

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PINELLAS PARK MIDDLE SCHOOL MUSIC BOOSTERS, INC.,

(A Not for Profit Corporation)

The Board of Trustees of Pinellas Park Middle School Music Boosters, Inc., having adopted Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation by majority vote at its Board School Meeting on June 7, 1999 amends the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE II

The general nature and purpose of this corporation shall be to conduct all such lawful activity available to any legal entity including, but not limited to, the following:

To raise funds for the purchase of equipment and materials for the Pinellas Park Middle School Band and Chorus.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational in nature within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United Sates Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an

organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future internal revenue code, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE IX

These Articles may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Trustees at any regular or special meeting at which a quorum is present. There are no members of the Corporation entitled to vote on a proposed amendment.
