ARTICLES OF CORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be the Miami Women's Sports and Educational League, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be within the City of Miami, Miami-Dade County, Florida. The mailing address is P.O. Box 695049 Miami, Florida 33269.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are) to use sports and educational programs to deter the youth from gangs, drugs, teen pregnancy and every day problems. Our purpose will be as follows:

Advancement of education among the youth:

By providing instruction in the preparation of entering the job market.

Eliminating Prejudice and Discrimination:

By working together along with other groups sharing the same goals and purpose.

Combating community deterioration and juvenile delinquency:

By being positive role models for our youth and offering them alternative avenues for expression of their views.

Lessening the neighborhood tensions:

By offering healthy competition and instilling good sportsman like conduct.

Participating in sporting events:

By being competitive in different sporting events and on a frequent bases to keep the youths mind and bodies occupied on events other than gangs, drugs, and every day problems.

Bridging the gap between the youth and police:

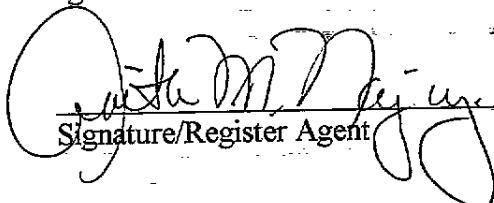
