ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION:

OF

VISION 2004, INC.

I.

The name of this corporation is VISION 2004, INC., A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION.

II.

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

III.

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted by said corporation shall be as follows:

To support social and economic development, charitable causes and projects, to operate, foster and encourage public service endeavors, and to work towards unity and progress in Florida and abroad.

That of engaging in any activity permitted under the laws of the United States of America, its territories, districts, and possessions, and any activity permitted under the laws of the State of Florida, and to have, exercise, and enjoy the powers and privileges granted to corporations not for profit by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

To do all and everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, of the attainment of any of the objects, or for the furtherance of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or

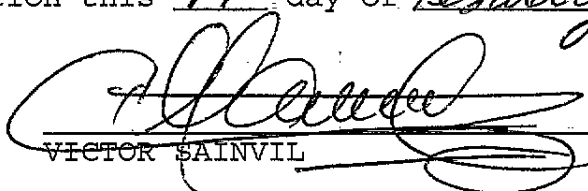

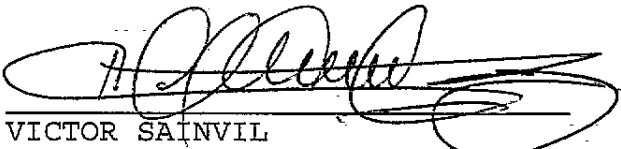
