Articles of Incorporation of SageWays Center, Inc.

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Article I: Name

The name of the organization will be <u>SageWays Center</u>, <u>Inc.</u>, <u>hereinafter referred to as the Corporation</u>.

Article II: Principal office and/or mailing address

The address of the principal office of the Corporation is <u>230 Royal</u> Palm Way, Suite 405, Palm Beach, FL 33480.

Article III: Purpose

SageWays Center, Inc. is a not-for-profit corporation, organized for the purpose of the interdisciplinary exploration of the whole person - body, mind and spirit, which will include education, research, treatment and other activities related to enriching the totality of human life, and for the purpose of engaging in any lawful act or activity not for pecuniary profit for which not-for-profit corporations may be organized, so far as is or may be permitted by the laws of the State of Florida and Section 501[c][3] of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Article IV: Membership

Any person, corporation, partnership, association or organization, who is interested in the purposes of the Corporation, who is capable of contributing to the achievement of those purposes and the effective operation of the Corporation, shall be eligible for membership. Special categories of membership, with attendant requirements may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors. No share certificates will be issued.

Article V: Initial Registered Office and Agent

Article VI: Board of Directors

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of no less than three [3] directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time, in accordance with the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall never be less than three. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation [except as otherwise provided in subsection [h] of Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986], and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in [including the publishing or distributing of statements] any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
