ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

Putnam-Diamond-Community-Transit/Management, Inc.

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act adopts the following Article of Incorporations for such corporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation is Putnam-Diamond-Community-Transit/Management, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be 907 St. Johns Avenue, Palatka, FL 32177, and any other address in Putnam County.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE(S)

The corporation is established under Florida Statute 617 for not-for-profit corporations and is intended to comply with the rules and regulations that would qualify the corporation under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) as a business not organized for profit and not part of the earnings inures to the benefit of any one shareholder.

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

To manage and provide

1. Transportation for residents of Palatka/Putnam County and any other public and private transportation to Low income persons in Putnam County or any other county in the State of Florida.

2. Education, Recreation and economic development and management training, to enhance the quality of life of residents of Putnam County, Palatka.

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE XI - EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of this corporation will be March 4, 1999.
