ST. JOHNS No. 29

Sir Knight W. C. Cooper Capt. General

A Dispensation to form said COMMANDERY having been issued on the day of A. D., and said COMMANDERY having continued under said Dispensation until the present conclave of the GRAND COMMANDERY; a copy of the minutes of their proceedings having been submitted for our inspection and approval, and no cause adverse to the granting of the prayer of said applicants to us appeared.

Now Know Ye, That we the GRAND COMMANDERY of KNIGHTS TEMPLAR of the STATE of FLORIDA, reposing special confidence and trust in the fidelity, Knightly zeal, and ability of the members of said COMMANDERY, by virtue of the power in us vested DO BY THESE PRESENTS authorize and empower said COMMANDERY, when regularly constituted and established under the jurisdiction of this GRAND COMMANDERY, with full and adequate powers to elect their officers, to admit members, and confer the several orders of:

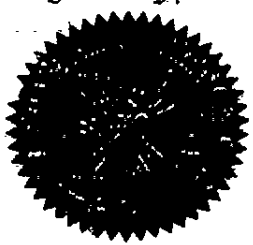
ILLUSTRIOUS ORDER OF THE RED CROSS  
KNIGHT OF MALTA and KNIGHT TEMPLAR

In accordance with the lawful established usages of said ORDERS OF KNIGHTHOOD upon such person or persons possessing the requisite qualifications as they may think proper; and to do and perform all acts and to have and exercise all power and authority of a regular COMMANDERY OF KNIGHTS TEMPLAR. And we recognize the present members of the said Commandery with a continuance of the said powers and privileges to them, their associates and their successors, forever. Provided Always, that the officers and members of said Commandery, and their successors, pay due respect to THE GRAND ENCAMPMENT and to the Constitution, Statutes and Edicts thereof, and to our Grand Commandery and the Statutes and Regulations thereof, with the general principles and usages of our Order; otherwise this Charter, and all things therein contained, to be void and of no effect.

Given at the city of MARIANNA and State of Florida, this 30th day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand, Nine Hundred and forty-six and of our Order Seven hundred and Twenty-eight.
