ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR MILLENIUM METAPHYSICAL MINISTRIES, INC.

ARTICLE I

Name.

The name of the corporation is: Millenium Metaphysical Ministries, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principal place of business and mailing address.

The present principal place of business of the corporation is 1905 Southwest 13th Street, Gainesville, FL, 32608, and the mailing address of this corporation is 1905 Southwest 13th Street, Gainesville, FL 32608, or such other address as designated in the Annual Report.

ARTICLE III

Purpose.

The purpose for which the corporation is formed and the business and objectives to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The purpose of the corporation shall be to promote the advancement of mental health through Meridian Behavioral Healthcare, Inc., and its objectives, and to such end, to take and hold, either absolutely or in trust, for the furtherance of said purpose, funds and property of all kinds, subject only to any limitation or condition imposed by law or the instrument under which received.

To this end, the Corporation is empowered to perform all acts authorized by law; provided, however, the corporation shall not engage in any activity that is not permitted by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any corresponding future provision of the Revenue Code, and the Corporation shall not attempt to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise, nor shall it intervene in or participate in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member or private individual, and no member, director, or officer of the Corporation shall receive any pecuniary benefit from the Corporation, except such reasonable compensation as may be allowed for services actually rendered to the Corporation.

Distribution on dissolution.

Upon the dissolution or other termination of the Corporation, no part of the property of the Corporation or any of the proceeds shall be distributed to or inured to the benefit of any of the members of the Corporation, but all such property and proceeds, subject to the discharge of valid obligations of the Corporation, shall be distributed as directed by members of the Corporation among one or more corporations, trusts, community chests, funds, or foundations organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes, no part of the net earnings of which inure to the benefit of any private shareholder, member, or individual, and no substantial part of whose activities consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or which does not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate or public office, or other entities of the type which qualify for federal income tax exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or subsequent amendments.

ARTICLE XI.

Right to indemnification.

To the extent permitted by the law of Florida, the corporation shall indemnify any person who was or is a party to any threatened, pending, or completed action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative, including all appeals by reason of the fact that person is r was acting as a director, officer, or employee of the Corporation. Indemnification shall be against all expenses, including without limitation, attorney's fees, court costs, expert witness fees, judgments, decrees, and fines reasonably and actually incurred by the person in settlement of any action, suit, or proceedings provided that the Board of Directors shall first have determined, in its sole judgment, that the person acted in good faith and in a manner that he or she reasonably believed to be in the best interest of the Corporation, and with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful. The termination of any action, suit, or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction, or on a plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent, shall not of itself create a presumption that the person did not act in good faith and in a manner which he or she reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the Corporation.
