ARTICLE XIV Statement of Faith

1.1 Statement on Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality

We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. (Gen 1:26-27.) Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person.

We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture. (Gen 2:18-25.)

We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. (1 Cor 6:18; 7:2-5; Heb 13:4.) We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman.

We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, and use of pornography) is sinful and offensive to God. (Matt 15:18-20; 1 Cor 6:9-10.)

We believe that in order to preserve the function and integrity of [the organization] as the local Body of Christ, and to provide a biblical role model to the [the organization] members and the community, it is imperative that all persons employed by [the organization] in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers, agree to and abide by this Statement on Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality. (Matt 5:16; Phil 2:14-16; 1 Thess 5:22.)

We believe that God offers redemption and restoration to all who confess and forsake their sin, seeking His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus Christ. (Acts 3:19-21; Rom 10:9-10; 1 Cor 6:9-11.) We believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity. (Mark 12:28-31; Luke 6:31.) Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward any individual are to be repudiated and are not in accord with Scripture nor the doctrines of Iglesia Cristiana El Taller Del Carpintero.

1.2 Statement of Final Authority for Matters of Faith and Conduct

The statement of faith does not exhaust the extent of our beliefs. The Bible itself, as the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of mankind, is the sole and final source of all that we believe. For purposes of [the organization]'s faith, doctrine, practice, policy, and discipline, our [minister/executive committee/board of directors] is [the organization]'s final interpretive authority on the Bible's meaning and application.

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1.3 Statement on the Sanctity of Human Life

We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life. (Ps 139.)

2.0 Church Employment Criteria

This church require to all employees and volunteers to sign a statement affirming that they agree with the organization's statement of faith and are willing to comply with the organization's standards of conduct.

Violation of the organization's statement of faith constitutes good cause to terminate employment.

3.0 Facility Use Policy

- 1. Groups or persons requesting facility use must affirm that their beliefs and practices and planned uses of the facilities are consistent with the church's faith and practice.
- 2. The group or person seeking facility use must submit a signed "Church Facility Reservation Request and Agreement" form.
- 3. the group or person seeking facility use must be willing to take responsibility for the facilities and equipment used and must agree to abide by the church's rules of conduct for facility use, as stated below and as described in any additional instructions by church staff.

Facility Use Guidelines

- 1. Alcohol Policy: No alcohol may be served in church facilities.
- 2. Smoking Policy: smoking in any indoor church facilities is prohibited.
- 3. Groups are restricted to only those areas of the facility that the group has reserved.
- 4. Food and beverages in classrooms, worship space, not allowed.
- 5. Church equipment, such as tables and chairs, must be returned to original placement, unless arranged otherwise prior to the event.
- 6. All lights must be turned off and doors locked upon departure.
- 7. Clean-up it is the responsibility of the group using the facility, and if so, what constitutes satisfactory clean-up.
- 8. Abusive or foul language, violent behavior, and drug or alcohol abuse are strictly prohibited on church premises. Any person exhibiting such behavior will be required to leave the premises.

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- 9. Any person or group must sign the "Church Facility Reservation Request and Agreement" form prior to reservation of church facilities.
- 10. Insurance For all non-church-sponsored events, the group or person using the facilities must obtain liability insurance coverage. The user must also sign a "Facility Use and an Indemnity and Hold Harmless Agreement."

4.0 Membership Policy

The membership of this Church shall be composed of individuals who are believers in the Lord Jesus Christ and affirm the tenets of the Church Constitution, and who offer evidence, by their confession and their conduct, that they are living in accord with their affirmations and this Constitution and Bylaws, and are actively pursuing and continuing in a vital fellowship with the Lord, Jesus Christ. The pastoral board of this Church shall have final authority in all matters of church governance, as set forth and described in the Bylaws.

4.1 Marriage Policy

Because God has ordained marriage and defined it as the covenant relationship between a man, a woman, and Himself, *Iglesia Cristiana El Taller Del Carpintero* will only recognize marriages between a biological man and a biological woman. Further, the pastors and staff of *Iglesia Cristiana El Taller Del Carpintero* shall only participate in weddings and solemnize marriages between one man and one woman. Finally, the facilities and property of *Iglesia Cristiana El Taller Del Carpintero* shall only host weddings between one man and one woman.

4.2 Our Bible Principles

We believe in the Bible as the divine Word of God, the revelation of his mind and will to man, Our infallible, all sufficient guide to salvation and a life as a believer. (II Tim 3.16-17)

We believe in only one God, the Creator of everything; eternal, infinite and immutable in three divine persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit (1 John 5: 7-8).

We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, who is true God and man born of a virgin by the Holy Spirit,. (Jn 1:18; Lc1: 26-35)

We believe in the total depravity of human beings since his fall in the Garden of Eden and the absolute inability of man to save himself from eternal punishment by his own efforts. (Romans 3: 10-18, 23: 5: 12-18; Psalm 14: 1-3)

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We believe that Christ died for our sins, was buried and rose again the third day, and personally appeared to His disciples. (1 Corinthians 15: 1-4; Romans 4:25)

We believe in the bodily ascension of Jesus to heaven, His exaltation and glorious to return for His church (John 14: 2, 3, 1 Thessalonians 4: 13-18; Romans 4:25)

We believe in the declaration of sinners by grace through repentance and the cross of Calvary by which we obtain remission of sins. (Efec. 2: 8-9, Hebrews 9:12, 22; Romans 5:11.)

We believe in the necessity of baptism by immersion in the name of the triune God, according to the mandate given by Christ. (Mt.28: 19,

Acts 2: 34-36, 19: 1-6)

We believe in the baptism of the Holy Spirit as an experience subsequent to salvation. (Hch2, 8: 14-17; 10: 44-46; Gal 3: 14-15)

We believe in the manifestation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and is listed in 1 Cor 12-14m thus manifested in the Early Church.

We believe in the Spirit-filled life, a life dedicated to the perfection of holiness in the fear of God as an expression of the Christian faith (1 Corinthians 6:14; II Cor 7: 1)

We believe that Jesus Christ is the head of the Church, the Lord of the believer, the high priest over the house of God and the Defender of the family of God.
