ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>



INTERNATIONAL ALZHEIMER'S FOUNDATION TRUST OF HIGHLANDS COUNTY, INC.

In order to form a corporation under and in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida: for the formation of a corporation not for profit, pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, we, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves into a corporation with the purposes and with the powers hereinafter mentioned: and to that end, we do, by these Articles of Incorporation, set forth:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be INTERNATIONAL ALZHEIMER'S FOUNDATION TRUST OF HIGHLANDS COUNTY, INC.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation shall be located at 2277 SW Olympic Club Terrace, Palm City, Florida 34990, but the Corporation may maintain offices and transact business in such other places within or without the state of Florida as may from time to time be designated by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The purpose and object of the corporation shall be to fund, research, construct, and participate in building assisted living housing for people afflicted with Alzheimer's and other related dementia diseases without regard of race, greed, religious preference, or gender.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is by majority vote of the members..

<u>EXISTENCE</u>

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VII

NET EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of

this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of ant future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII

CORPORATE POWERS

The Corporation shall have the following powers:

- 1. The Corporation shall have all of the powers and privileges set forth and described in Chapter 617.021, Florida Statutes as amended from time to time, relating to corporations not for profit.
- 2. The Corporation shall have all of the powers reasonably necessary to implement and effectuate the purposes of the Corporation.
