AMENDMENTS ADOPTED

Add the following language:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE:

This association is organized exclusively for educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

No part of the net earnings of the association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the association shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the association shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the association shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an association exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by an association, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

DISSOLUTION: The association may be dissolved in the manner provided in the Bylaws. The text of the proposed dissolution shall provide legally for termination of the association's existence and upon dissolution of this association assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose.
