ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

RESTORATION MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL, INC.

A Corporation Not For Profit

BY THESE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, THE INCORPORATORS FORM A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT UNDER FLORIDA LAW.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be RESTORATION MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL, INC. corporation not for profit, and its principal place of business and place for worship as a church shall be in Broward County, Florida.

ARTICLE II

Corporate Nature

This is a non-profit corporation, organized solely for general religious, charitable, and educational purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit Law set forth in Section 617 of the Florida Statutes, and as amended.

ARTICLE III

Duration

The term of existence of this corporation is perpetual commencing on the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Secretary of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

General And Specific Purposes

The specific and primary purposes for which the corporation is formed shall be:

- 1. To forster, promote and perpetuate the Christian Faith according to the Holy Scripture now taught and exemplified by this Church and as adhered to by its members.
- 2. To teach the Bible and to hold and conduct religious services in accordance with the rights and doctrines of the Bible and to conduct a church of churches, school of schools, and

other institutions connected therewith or incidental or auxiliary thereto, of a religious, educational, charitable or benevolent character, to the end that its own members and others may be generally instructed, guided and spiritually enlightened, and for the growth, benefit, instruction and enlightenment morally of the said members and of the community in which it is located.

- 3. To help the poor and needy, and to promote educational, charitable, and social institutions and undertakings in any other place that the members and of this corporation may see fit.
- 4. To operate exclusively in any other manner for such religious, charitable and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, including private foundations and private operating foundations.

ARTICLE V

Powers

For the purpose of the promoting the foregoing general and specific purposes this corporation shall have the right to acquire, either by gift or purchase, and to hold, own, sell, mortgage, or encumber in any manner, lease and improve, real estate and personal property, for itself and others, either as Trustee or otherwise.

It shall have power to sue and be sued, to make and use a common seal, to execute deeds and mortgages, bill of sales, leases, agreements, and such other written instruments as may be necessary to carry out said power and authority, and to further the said objects and purposes.

It shall have the power to make By-Laws not inconsistent or contrary to law of the regulation of its affairs and the management of its property, the same to subject to amendment when desirable, pursuant to the methods therein provided.

It shall have the power to do any and all things necessary or expedient for carrying out the objects and purposes of the corporation, and in general to possess all rights, privileges and immunities, and enjoy all the benefits granted to corporations of similar character under the law of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VI

Use of Income

All revenue, profit, income and money received from the conduct of this corporation is to be used and employed in religious, educational, charitable, or benevolent work, and not for the benefit of the members of said corporation, either individually or collectively, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein.

ARTICLE VII

Membership

Every person who believes in repentance toward God and faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and the Lord and in the Holy Scripture as taught and exemplified by this Church, and whose application for membership shall have been approved by this Church through its adopted procedure, and who are thereafter in good standing through regular attendance of worship and carried on the membership role of this Church shall be qualified members of the Church.

Membership shall continue thereafter for said members for life for so long as they remain in good standing.

ARTICLE IX

Management of Corporate Affairs

The financial and business affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of a minimum of three (3) Trustees pursuant to the By-Laws of this corporation.
