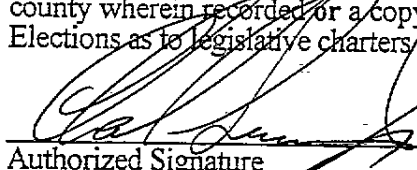

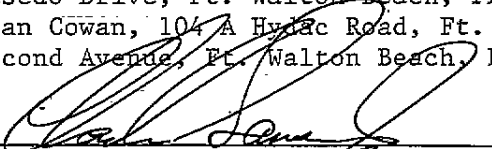
The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is:

CHARTER OF OCEAN CITY BAPTIST CHURCH

A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, HEREBY ASSOCIATE OURSELVES TOGETHER IN A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA UNDER THE FOLLOWING CHARTER:

I.

THE NAME OF THE CORPORATION SHALL BE OCEAN CITY BAPTIST CHURCH, AND IT WILL BE LOCATED IN THE COMMUNITY OF OCEAN CITY NEAR SHALIMAR, FLORIDA.

II.
