# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

# TROPICAL SPORTS CAR CLUB, INC.



These Articles of Incorporation are signed by the Incorporator(s) for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, F.S. Chapter 617, as amended, as follows:

### ARTICLE I

#### Name

The name of the corporation is Tropical Sports Car Club, Inc.

## ARTICLE II

#### **Purposes and Powers**

The purposes for which the corporation is formed and the powers it may exercise are as follows:

- 1. To promote and further the enjoyment of sports car rallying.
- 2. To exercise any power which is consistent with the purposes described above and which a not for profit corporation organized under the provisions of the Florida Corporation Not For Profit Corporation Act may exercise, but no other power.

#### ARTICLE III

### Registered Office and Resident Agent

# Form of Organization, Assets, and Financing

### **ARTICLE VI**

#### ARTICLE VII

# Limitation of Volunteer Directors' Liability

A volunteer director shall not be personally liable to the corporation for monetary damages for breach of the director's fiduciary duty, except that a volunteer director's liability is not limited for:

- (1) a breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the corporation;
- (2) acts or omissions not in good faith or that involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law;
- (3) a violation of F.S. §617.0505 and F.S. §617.0833 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, which relates to the making of unauthorized distributions or loans;
  - (4) a transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit; or
  - (5) an act or omission that is grossly negligent.

The corporation shall assume all liability to any person other than the corporation for all acts or omissions of a volunteer director incurred in the good faith performance of the volunteer director's duties as such.

If, after the adoption of this article, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act is amended to further eliminate or limit the liability of a volunteer director, then a volunteer director (in addition to the circumstances in which a volunteer director is not personally liable as set forth in the preceding paragraph) shall, to the fullest extent permitted by the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, not be liable to the corporation, as so amended. No amendment to or alteration, modification or repeal of this article shall increase the liability or alleged liability of any volunteer director of the corporation for or with respect to any acts or omissions of such director occurring

prior to such amendment, alteration, modification or repeal.

# ARTICLE VIII

# **Indemnification of Directors and Officers**

The corporation may indemnify its present and past directors, officers, employees and agents, and such other persons as it shall have the power to indemnify, to the fullest extent permitted under the laws of the State of Florida as they now exist or may hereafter be amended, but subject to any limitations provided in the corporation's bylaws.

# ARTICLE IX

### Amendments

The corporation may amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation and add additional articles in the manner prescribed by statute.
