**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article I: The name of the corporation

The name of the corporation shall be JESUS PEOPLE OF TAMPA BAY, INC.

Article II: The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 4410 West Sligh Avenue, Tampa, FL 33607.

Article III: The specific purpose (s) for which the corporation is organized.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to carry on all lawful transactions, business and activities, not for pecuniary profit. The primary purpose of the corporation is religious purposes and shall include promoting and fostering the dissemination of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Word of God as disclosed in the Holy Bible.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (1986) as hereafter amended.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (1986) as hereafter amended, or shall be distributed to the federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas, of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

Article IV: The manner in which the Directors are elected or appointed.

The Board of Directors shall be vested with the management of the affairs of the corporation and may be named otherwise in the Bylaws, such as Trustees. The directors of the corporation shall be appointed as provided in the Bylaws of this corporation. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors shall be at least three.

Article V: The name and Florida street address of the initial registered agent.
