SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE. FLORIDA

Central Asia School Enrichment Foundation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

No part of the net earning of the Central Asia School Enrichment Foundation Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Central Asia School Enrichment Foundation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Central Asia School Enrichment Foundation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Central Asia School Enrichment Foundation Inc. shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Central Asia School Enrichment Foundation Inc. shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

Upon dissolution of the Central Asia School Enrichment Foundation Inc. assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or shall be distributed to the Federal, State, or Local Government for a public purpose.
