ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

MESSENGERS OF THE MESSIAH, INC.



The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles Of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be:

MESSENGERS OF THE MESSIAH, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The principal place of business; and mailing address of this ____ corporation shall be:

128 Twin Oak Dr., FL 32536

ARTICLE III.

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- a. To conduct worship services.
- b. To proclaim the full Gospel of Jesus Christ and urge acceptance of His salvation.
- c. To further the Kingdom of God throughout the world.
- d. To promote Bible study and training.
- e. To present Bibles to those who express a desire to receive a Bible.

ARTICLE IV.

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Eligibility for Ministorial Ordination and/or LicenseThose requesting ordination and/or licensing in a ministorial
capacity MUST believe those items as setforth in Article III and
shall meet with the Board of Directors for conformation and shall
be voted on by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V.

Licenses shall be reviewed annually or at such time as a licensee shall ask to be removed from MESSENGERS OF THE MESSIAH, INC. However, anyone deemed undesirable by acts or deeds that tend to jeoparidze MESSENGERS OF THE MESSIAH, INC., can be expelled by the removal of the minister's license at any time by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI.

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

The manner in which the Board of Directors shall be elected
is stated in the By-Laws of this ministry.

The name of the incorporators of this corporation and address (business address) Patricia M. Anchors, 128 Twin Oak Dr., Crestview, FL 32536.

ARTICLE VII.

All offices, positions, memberships, license, et. are non-transferrable.

In the event of dissolution of final liquidation of the corporation, all assets, rights and interest of the corporation shall be transferred to a non-profit organization that is non-profit as defined by the Internal Revenue Service in Section 501 (3) (c).

f. To present to others the gospel of the one true God, who has revealed Himself as the eternally self-existent "I AM", Creator of heaven and earth and the Redeemer of mankind. He has further revealed Himself as embodying the principles of relationship and association as Father, Son, and Holy Ghost (Duet. 6:4; Isa. 43:10, 11; Matt. 28:19; Luke 3:22). The Lord Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God.

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The Scriptures declare:

- a. His virgin birth (Matt. 1:23; Luke 1:31, 35)
- b. His sinless life (Heb 7:26; 1 Peter 2:22)
- c. His miracles (Acts 2:22; 10:38)
- d. His substitutionary work on the cross (1 Cor. 15:3; 2 Cor. 5:21)
- e. His body resurrection from the dead (Matt. 28:6; Luke 24:39; 1 Cor. 15:4)
- f. His exaltation to the right hand of God (Acts 1:9, 11; 2:33; Phil. 2:9-11; Heb 1-3)

That man was created good and upright; for God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness." However man by voluntary transgression fell and thereby incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death, which is separation from God (Gen. 1:26, 27; 2:17; 3:6; Rom 5:12 - 19).

That man's only hope of redemption is through the shed blood of Jesus Christ the Son of God.

(a) Condition of Salvation:

Salvation is received through repentance toward God and faith toward the Lord Jesus Christ, by the washing or regeneration and renewing of the Holy Ghost, being justified by grace through faith, man becomes an heir of God according to the hope of eternal life. (Luke 24:47; John 3:3; Rom 10:13-15; Eph 2:8; Titus 2:11; 3:5-7).

(b) The evidence of salvation being the inward evidence of salvation by the direct witness of the Spirit with our spirit (Rom 8:16). The outward evidence to all men is a life of righteousness and true holiness (Eph 4:24; Titus 2:12).

To further encourage, promote, educate those in need spiritually, physically, mentally, and emotionally.

To secure, train, license and ordain into the ministry those having expressed a call upon their life to preach the Word of The Living God and to license workers to perform services after they have accepted the call of God.

To establish church, schools, and educational doctrine training centers.

To perform any and other other lawful act as provided by the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VIII

Voting - shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary-Treasurer.

ARTICLE IX

Messengers Of The Messiah, Inc., its officers, and directors shall not be liable for any activities of whatsoever kind or nature which are not directly under control and direction of the Board of Directors. Any such activities shall be conducted solely at the risk and responsibility of such individual or individuals.

No licensed minister or worker purporting to speak in a capacity or on behalf of said corporation shall issue, publish or make any statement or take any position on any national or general policy, regulating rule or other matter effecting corporation without first securing approval of the corporation in writing.
