## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CONNECTICUT SOCIETY OF NAPLES/MARCO ISLAND, INC. (A Corporation Not-For-Profit)

#### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation (the "Corporation") is CONNECTICUT SOCIETY OF NAPLES/MARCO ISLAND, INC.

#### ARTICLE II

The principal office or mailing address of the Corporation is 174 South Collier Blvd., Marco Island, Florida 34145.

#### ARTICLE III

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (the "Code") and is not formed for pecuniary profit or financial gain. The Corporation is authorized to perform any lawful act or activity for which corporations not-for-profit may be formed under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not have or exercise any power which would cause it not to qualify as a tax-exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Code; nor shall the Corporation engage directly or indirectly in any activity which would cause the loss of such qualification.

#### ARTICLE IV

The members of the Corporation shall consist of the individuals constituting the Board of Directors hereinafter provided, and their successors in office. The qualification for membership in the Corporation may be modified as provided in the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE V

The number of Directors constituting the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be as provided in the Bylaws, provided, however, the number of Directors shall not be less than three (3). The manner in which the Directors are to be elected or appointed shall be as stated in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as

Title to all property of the Corporation shall be held in the name of the Corporation or as otherwise may be provided pursuant to the authority of the Bylaws of the Corporation. Any gift, bequest, devise or donation of any kind whatsoever to the Corporation or its Board of Directors shall be deemed to vest title in the Corporation.

#### ARTICLE IX

These Articles may be amended as provided in the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE X

Upon the liquidation or dissolution of the Corporation, its assets, if any, remaining after payment (or provision for payment) of all liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to one or more organizations qualified as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

#### ARTICLE XI

#### ARTICLE XII

Section 1. Prohibition on Private Inurement. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, no part of the net earnings, current or accumulated, or property of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any member (other than a member which is exempt from federal income tax under section  $501(\vec{c})(3)$  of the Code), director, officer, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services actually rendered and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Prohibition on Dividends</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not have the power to declare dividends.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Limitation on Lobbying Activities</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, no substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

Section 4. <u>Prohibition on Intervening in Political Campaigns</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Tax-Exempt Status</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be

carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under sections 170(c)(2), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2) of the Code.

#### ARTICLE XIII

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, during such period, or periods, as the Corporation is treated as a "private foundation" pursuant to section 509 of the Code, the Corporation must comply with the following:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Taxable Distributions</u>. The Corporation shall distribute its net revenues at such time and in such manner so as not to subject the Corporation to tax under section 4942 of the Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Self-Dealing</u>. The Corporation shall be prohibited from engaging in any act of self-dealing (as defined in section 4941(d) of the Code).

<u>Section 3</u> <u>Excess Business Holdings</u>. The Corporation shall be prohibited from retaining any excess business holding (as defined in section 4941(d) of the Code) which would subject the Corporation to tax under section 4945 of the Code.

<u>Section 4</u> <u>Jeopardizing Investments</u>. The Corporation shall be prohibited from making any investments or otherwise acquiring assets in such manner so as to subject the Corporation to tax under section 4944 of the Code. Further, the Corporation shall be prohibited from retaining any assets which would subject the Corporation to tax under section 4944 of the Code if the Directors have acquired such assets.

<u>Section 5</u> <u>Taxable Expenditures</u>. The Corporation shall be prohibited from making any taxable expenditures (as defined in section 4945(d) of the Code).

#### ARTICLE XIV

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer, director or employee, or any former officer, director or former employee, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
