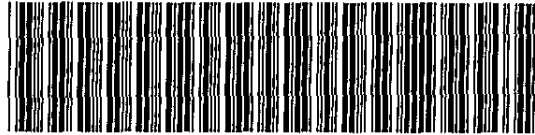


**ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION
