<u>ARTICLE ONE - NAME</u>

The name of this corporation is The PAL Academy Charter Schools of Manatee County, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO - DURATION

The existence of this corporation is to be perpetual. Corporate existence shall commence with filing the Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE THREE - STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE

This is a non-profit corporation set us on a non-stock basis organized solely for general charitable purpose pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE FOUR - PURPOSES

Section 1(2), Ch. 96-186, Laws of Florida, states the various purposes for opening charter schools.

PAL Academy Charter School:

Mission/Purpose is to provide an alternative educational program for students with different learning styles. The emphasis will be placed on the physical, emotional, social and intellectual development of each learner to empower them to achieve the highest level of academic excellence and success.

The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such charitable purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations qualifying as tax-exempt organizations under that Code.

This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry our

propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE FIVE - DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE SIX - MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the board of directors. Any person paying dues as provided for in the by-laws and agreeing to be bound by the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation, by its by-laws, and by such rules and regulations as the directors may from time to time adopt, is eligible for membership in the corporation. The directors shall from time to time prescribe the form and manner in which application may be made for membership.

ARTICLE TEN - MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

(a) <u>Board of Directors:</u> The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of directors.
