The undersigned incorporator hereby forms a non-profit corporation under Chapter 617 of the laws of the State of Florida.

FIRST: Name: The name of the corporation shall be:

SECOND: Nature of Business: This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, spiritual purposes and to function as a religious institution, including, for such purposes, the making of distribution to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The Corporation shall help to educate the

general public about the positive and necessary role women play in the family and society, obtain funds from private and public sources for the purpose of educating and empowering women to take a more positive role in their family and in society. The Corporation shall engage in various fund raising activities to achieve the above-mentioned purposes, including the application for and receipt of grants from State or Federal governmental authorities, public and private foundations, and individuals. The Corporation shall also engage in any lawful business or activities related thereto and engage in any other lawful act where activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Not For Profit Chapter.

FOURTH: Election of Directors: The method of election of directors is as stated in the bylaws.

FIFTH: Members: The Corporation may have memberships and may establish by its by-laws such classes, divisions, and types of memberships as may be determined necessary for the purposes and furtherance of the purposes stated herein, provided, however, the membership shall not be restricted on the grounds of race, creed, color or sex.
