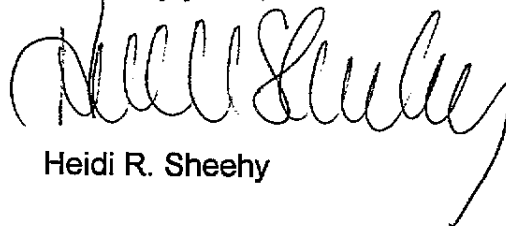

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

- of -

TAMPA BAY BLADES, INC.

A Florida Nonprofit Corporation

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ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be:

TAMPA BAY BLADES, INC.

ARTICLE II

The address of the principal office of this Corporation shall be 1620 Storington Avenue, Brandon, Florida 33511 and the mailing address of the Corporation shall be 1620 Storington Avenue, Brandon, Florida 33511.

ARTICLE III

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual, and the corporate existence will commence on the filing of these Articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE IV

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized is as follows:

1. To organize and promote recreational and competitive women's and girl's ice hockey.
2. Generally to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of Florida, or which may hereafter be conferred, including the power to contract, rent, buy, or sell personal or real property; provided, however, that this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this Corporation.
3. Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities

or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this Corporation.

ARTICLE V

The method of election of the directors of the Corporation is set forth in the bylaws.

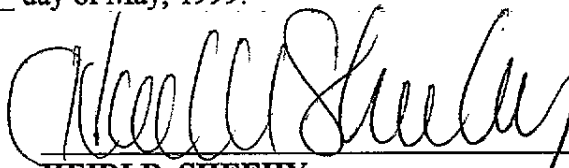
ARTICLE VII

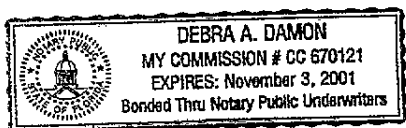

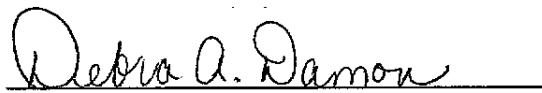
