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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF

TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

SPECIAL ITY AVIATION TRAINING CENTER, INC.

TO: The Florida Department of State:

The undersigned, as incorporator of SPECIALITY AVIATION TRAINING CENTER INC., adopted the below-detailed Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation at a special meeting held on December 10th, 1999.

The incorporator made such amendments prior to the issuance of any shares of stock in the above-named corporation. The adopted amendments to the Articles of Incorporation are as follows:

- 1. Article I Name, SPECIALTY AVIATION TRAINING CENTER, INC.
- 2. Article III. Purposes, shall be amended to state:

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is: Educational services for the public, with emphasis on disadvantaged persons, and for any other purpose for which a not for profit corporation may do business in the State of Florida; and

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.); and

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.); and

Upon the dissolution of this corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

The effective date of this amendment is December 104, 1999.
