ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

To

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Of

We the People-Public Advocates of Florida, Inc.

Pursuant to provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted: **ARTICLE III PURPOSE** shall be amended to read as follows:

To provide a foundation of resources to assist and advocate the general population as to the functioning of bureaucracies in the areas of concern of building issues, property rights, taxing issues, improvement issues, permitting issues, and many other related issues as they arise. To provide advice, guidance and information regarding the functions of government to all citizens. To provide direction and support through the systems we the people are governed by in times when government seems to run the people. To provide an information network to break down the barriers of confusion and bureaucracy in an effort to re-establish the understanding that we are the government as opposed to being led by the government. To provide knowledge and information to assist the people of this great nation to understand the fundamentals of our governmental system, that we are the people, we are the system.

The purposes for which We the People-Public Advocates of Florida, Inc. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under

501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes with the meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
