ARTICLE I

Name

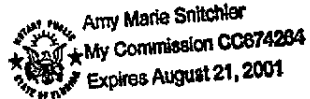

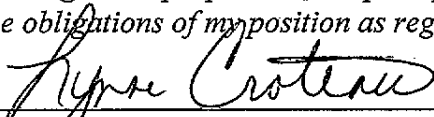
