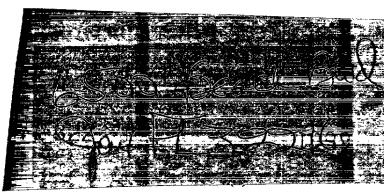
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## **Articles of Incorporation**

## **ARTICLE I**

#### <u>NAME</u>

The name of the Corporation is Golden Times Assistance Services, Inc.

## ARTICLE II

#### DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of this filing of these Articles with the Department of State.

## ARTICLE III

#### **PURPOSE**

- a. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statues. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation are:
  - (1) To assist needy senior citizens 65 years old and over to meet their basic life necessities such as:
    - a) Food, medicine, utility bills, and/or clothing;
    - b) Housing, rent, and/or repairs;
    - c) Provide transportation to hospitals, doctor appointments, shopping, etc.; and
      - d) Help them overcome loneliness by introducing them

to other single seniors\_at casual meetings.

- b. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- c. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.

## ARTICLE IV

## QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS

The qualifications of members of this corporation and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the bylaws of said corporation.

## ARTICLE V

## INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 1327 Tutter Street Jacksonville, Florida 32211 and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address is William D. Coleman.

## **ARTICLE VI**

## INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have four (4) Director constituting the initial Board of Directors. The number of directors may be either

increased or decreased from time to time by the bylaws; however, there shall never be less than three Directors. The name and address of the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is:

#### ARTICLE VIII

#### NONSTOCK BASIS

The Corporation is organized (and shall be operated) on a nonstock basis within the meaning of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, and shall not have the power to issue shares of any type or class of stock, but may issue membership certificates if so provided in the bylaws.

## ARTICLE IX

## INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall, to the fullest extent permitted by the Florida Corporation Act, as the same may be amended and supplemented, indemnify any and all persons whom it shall have power to indemnify under the said provisions from and against any and all the expenses,

liabilities, or other matters referred to in or covered by said provisions, and the indemnification provided for herein shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which those indemnified may be entitled under any Bylaw, or disinterested directors, or otherwise, both as to action in his or her official capacity and as to action while holding such office, and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be a director, officer, employee, or agent and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors, and administrators of such a person.

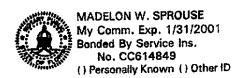
