NAME OF CORPORATION

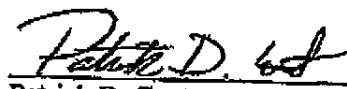

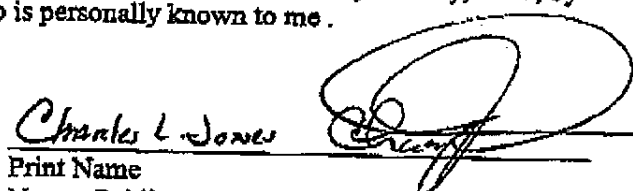

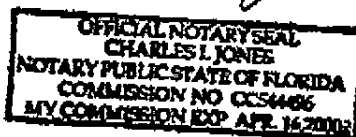
