

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ST JUDE FOUNDATION INC. A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION



The undersigned incorporator for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles Of Incorporation.

ARTICLE ONE - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be ST JUDE FOUNDATION INC.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE ELEVEN - DISSOLUTION OF CORPORATION

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The bylaws provides a dissolution provision for the assets of this corporation.

ARTICLE TWELVE - INDEMNIFICATION

To the full extent permitted by law this corporation should indemnify and hold harmless its director, officer employee, or agent, and any of its former officer, director, employee, or agent from any actions they take on behalf of the Corporation.

ARTICLE THIRTEEN - AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendments hereto.
