ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT  
TO  
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
CHRIST COMMUNITY CHURCH OF CAPE CORAL, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendment(s) adopted:

Article III of the Articles of this corporation is amended to read as follows:

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively Religious, charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Specifically, it is intended this corporation be a non-denominational church where people can come to learn and Worship the God of the Bible.

Article IX is added to the the Articles of this corporation and is to read as follows:

Any additional provisions for the operation of the corporation are as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of ay future United States Internal Revenue Law.

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
