# ADDITIONAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ASSOCIATION OF CHRISTIAN POLICE OFFICERS OF FLORIDA, INC

### ARTICLE EIGHT - DISTRIBUTION OF EARNINGS

No part of thr net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or any private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes.

#### ARTICLE NINE - PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on, (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or, (b) by a corporation contributions to which are dedutible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code). No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

### ARTICLE TEN - CORPORATE DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of this corporation, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
