

ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT to ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of



CHRISTIAN INSTITUTE OF ARTS & SCIENCES, Inc.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following article of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST:

Amendment adopted:

ARTICLE III. PURPOSES

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under 501(c)(3).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign.

Notwithstanding any provision of the Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductable under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Upon dissolution of said corporation, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to the State of Florida, or to a local government, for public purpose.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was: June 14, 2001.

THIRD: All members entitled to vote on the amendment voted in favor of its adoption on June 14, 2001.
