ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF MAY -8 PHE OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

Academy at the Lakes, Inc. A Florida Not for Profit Corporation May 6, 2008

The undersigned, acting as an officer of a corporation under Chapter 617 of Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

NAME OF CORPORATION: The name of the corporation is Academy at the Lakes, Inc., hereafter referred to as "Corporation".

PRINCIPAL OFFICE: The principal office of the Corporation is 2331 Collier Parkway, Land O' Lakes, Florida 34639.

MAILING ADDRESS: The mailing address of the Corporation is 2331 Collier Parkway, Land O' Lakes, Florida 34639.

REGISTERED AGENT: The name of the registered agent of the Corporation is NRAI Services, Inc. The address of the registered agent is 2731 Executive Park Drive, Suite 4, Weston, FL 33331.

DURATION: The period of duration is perpetual.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES: The method of selection of the Board of Trustees and number of trustees shall be stated in the Bylaws. The qualification for trustees and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the Bylaws.

OFFICERS: The method of selection of the officers and number of officers shall be stated in the Bylaws. The qualification for officers and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the Bylaws.

CORPORATE PURPOSES:

- A. The exclusive purpose of this Corporation is to engage in charitable, educational, religious, or scientific activities, including, for such purpose, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attaining of the foregoing purpose, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, association, trusts, institution, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.

501(c)(3) LIMITATIONS:

- A. CORPORATE PURPOSE: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on activities that are not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal and state income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. NO PRIVATE INUREMENT: The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profits or dividends to the Trustees or Officers thereof, or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out the Corporation's charitable and educational purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes no part of which shall inure the benefit of any individual.
- C. LOBBYING AND POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS: No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- D. DISSOLUTION: Upon winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. If the Corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by the decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which the Corporation's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.

INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify each officer and trustee, including former officers and trustees, non-trustee committee members and volunteers.
