We, the undersigned residents of the State of Florida, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the state of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

NAME. The name of this corporation shall be *THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF NEGRO* BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S CLUBS, INC. SOUTH FLORIDA CLUB, and its principal office shall be located at 1385 N. W. 50th Street, Miami, Dade County, Florida 33142.

ARTICLE II
