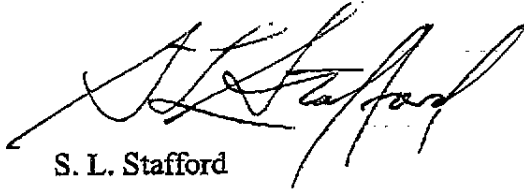

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
FOR

Commitment to Recovery, Inc

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SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

For the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, the incorporator hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is Commitment to Recovery, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business, and mailing address, of this corporation shall be:

15951 N Florida Ave
Lutz FL 33549

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific or educational, including in such purposes the making of distributions to other such organizations, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future Internal Revenue Code provision.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Sec 501(c)(3); or by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Sec 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future Internal Revenue Code provision.

The specific purpose of this corporation shall be to
educate the public on the problems of drug addiction, and
promote the study of alternative cures and recovery
techniques.

ARTICLE IV. MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The method of electing directors shall be as stated in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE V. RESTRICTION OF BENEFITS TO OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except as reasonable compensation for services rendered, or to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its Sec 501(c)(3) purpose. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be for propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation will not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, including but not limited to publishing or distributing statements.

ARTICLE VI. REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE VIII. DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Sec 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code or corresponding section of any future Internal Revenue provision, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
