**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BONOUVELLE CHRISTIAN CENTER, INC.**

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is BONOUVELLE CHRISTIAN CENTER, INC.,
The Corporation is a Religious Nonprofit Corporation.

ARTICLE II

The initial address of the corporation is as follows:

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which BONOUVELLE CHRISTIAN CENTER INC. is organized are as more fully described in Article VII herein.

ARTICLE IV

The manner in which the Trustees or Directors of the corporation are elected or appointed is governed by the provisions of the By-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII

The purposes for which BONOUVELLE CHRISTIAN CENTER, INC. is organized are:
To operate exclusively for religious, charitable, educational and distinct ecclesiastical purposes such as:

- A) Bringing the unsaved to a personal relationship with Christ.
- B) Conducting a local church by the direction of the Lord Jesus Christ and under the leadership of the Holy Spirit in accordance with all the commandments and provisions as set forth in the Holy Bible, the irrevocable Word of God. Pursuant thereto, the following activities and guidelines will be established:
 - 1) A recognized Creed, Code of Doctrine, discipline and form of worship will be established.
 - 2) An ecclesiastical form of government will be established.
 - 3) Ordination of ministers upon completion of the prescribed course of study, designated by this church ministry.
 - 4) An organization of ministers will be established to minister to the congregation of BONOUVELLE CHRISTIAN CENTER, INC.
 - 5) Establishment of a congregation membership based upon acceptance of a recognized creed and belief and support of the church.
 - 6) Spreading the Word of the Gospel through seminars, radio, television, establishment of church literature, and other forms of mass media for the purpose of educating the individual in the Word of God.
 - 7) Acquiring and holding such property, either real or personal, for church purposes, as may be necessary for its membership and the worship of God.

ARTICLE VIII

In accordance with and in addition to the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, the Nonprofit Corporation will have the following powers:

- A) To receive and accept gifts of money and property and to hold the same for any of the purposes of the Corporation and its work.

- B) To raise and assist in raising funds.
- C) To acquire, own, lease, mortgage and dispose of property, both real and personal.
- D) To conduct and carry on religious services and instruction through the public media, including electronic broadcasting, AM and FM radio, telecasting, microwave distribution, closed circuit transmission, the internet, and cable transmission.
- E) To acquire, own and operate such broadcasting and/or telecasting facilities.

ARTICLE IX

The business and properties of the corporation will be managed by a board of three or more Trustees (Directors). The present Trustees now duly constituted will hold their offices permanently until other or further election. In the event of the inability of any trustee to act, or the event of the death of any trustee the remaining trustees will elect another trustee to fill the vacancy created by a majority vote, excluding the trustee whose position is being filled.

In order to be a trustee, one should be a baptized member of the church, a good standing member of the community, and fulfill the requirements of I Timothy chapter three.

The Board of Trustees will be formed by a President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and Counselor(s).

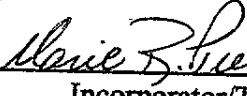
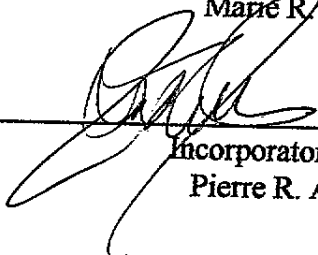
The Board of trustees will meet on the first Monday of every month to conduct and transact all business of the organization. If need be, the Board of trustees has the power to have supplemental meetings.

ARTICLE X

The Board of trustees is given power and authority to establish, institute, operate, and maintain any and all additional departments, associations, institutions, schools, mission stations, programs, and all other means as may be deemed appropriate and by the Board of trustees for the propagation of the gospel of Jesus Christ within the USA and throughout the world.

ARTICLE XI

The period of duration of the corporation will be perpetual.
