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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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We hereby associate to form a trust under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the laws of the State of Florida and to that end set forth the following:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is THE TRUST OF OTIS JAMES ROBBINS, JR., INC. C.O. St. Johns Baptist Church, 1328 NW 3rd Ave., Miami, FL 33136.

ARTICLE II:

The general nature and object of the trust is to receive public funds for the benefit of the household of Onicca Robbins.

In furtherance of the object of the trust, it may contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

ARTICLE III

The specific and primary purposes for which this trust is formed is:

A. To receive funds from the public for the benefit of the late James Otis Robbins, Jr., (deceased), funeral expenses, the sister Onicca Robbins (a minor), and her general household support.

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B. Any funds in excess shall be made available to the Dade Community Foundation exclusively for the children of Overtown.

C. Proceeds of the trust may be used to pay any and all necessary fees and expenses associated with the trust to include intrust fee, bank fees, legal fees, and related fees.

ARTICLE IV

This trust shall have a term of 180 days.

The powers of this trust shall be exercised, it's properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of trustees. The number of trustees of the trust shall be three (3).

The trustees named herein as the first board of trustees shall hold office until the first meeting of trustees, to be held on August 26, 1999, at C.O. St. Johns Baptist Church, 1328 NW 3rd Ave., Miami, FL 33136, at which time an election of trustees shall be held.

Trustees elected at the first annual meeting shall serve for a term of 180 days at which time the term of the trust will expire.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the board of trustees under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effects if taken by unanimous vote of the trustees. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by unanimous written consent of the board of trustees without a meeting and that the articles of incorporation and bylaws of this trust authorize the trustees to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.
