

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporators, all of whom are citizens of the United States, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation and certify:

ARTICLE I NAME:

The name of the corporation shall be Tampa Bay Association for Women Psychotherapists, Inc., A Florida Not for Profit Corporation.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE:

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Tampa Bay Association for Women Psychotherapists, Inc., shall be:

ARTICLE III PURPOSES:

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote and advance women in psychotherapy and related clinical practice and to improve the quality of care for women who are consumers of psychotherapy and related clinical practice, all of which purposes shall be interpreted to be within the meaning of section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IV EARNINGS:

The Not for Profit corporation is not organized for profit or to engage in an activity ordinarily carried on for profit. Neither shall any part of its net earnings inure to the benefit of any private individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt for federal income tax under section 501 (c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE V DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes for such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS:

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be set forth in the corporation's Bylaws.
