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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MAGDALENE CARNEY BAHA'I INSTITUTE, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the undersigned persons do hereby make, subscribe and acknowledge that they have voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, the Articles for which read as follows:

ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of this corporation is MAGDALENE CARNEY BAHA'I INSTITUTE, INC.

ARTICLE TWO OFFICE

The initial principal office of this corporation and the mailing address shall be located at 3735-B Shares Place, Riviera Beach, Florida 33404.

ARTICLE THREE PURPOSE

The purpose and general nature of the objectives for which this corporation is organized are exclusively for the purposes of religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law;

to engage in any activity incidental or conducive to the attainment of the purpose of this corporation, that lawfully can be conducted by a corporation organized under Chapter 617.001, et seq., Florida Statutes;

to engage in other activities and functions as are proper and in furtherance of the goals and purposes of the corporation; and

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to accept gifts, grants and contributions and to conduct fund raising activities in furtherance of the goals and purposes of the corporation.

The corporation shall be subject to the following provisions:

- a. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered;
- b. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- c. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- d. Upon the dissolution of the corporation and after paying or making provision for payment of all liabilities of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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ARTICLE FOUR REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

ARTICLE FIVE TERM OF EXISTENCE

The term of existence of this corporation is to be perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE SIX QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS

Qualification of members and the manner of their admission is to be provided for in the corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE SEVEN BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors are appointed as set forth in the Bylaws. The initial Board of Directors and their addresses are as follows:

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ARTICLE EIGHT NONSTOCK CORPORATION

The corporate shall be considered organized on a nonstock basis, and therefore, certificates of shares of stock in the corporation shall not be issued.

ARTICLE NINE DISSOLUTION

The corporation may be dissolved only by a majority vote of the Board of Directors of the corporation, and then only in accordance with the legal formalities necessary for the dissolution of a corporation pursuant to Section 617.1401 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE TEN BYLAWS

The first bylaws of this corporation will be adopted by the Board of Directors named herein. Upon prompt notice, the bylaws may be amended, altered, or rescinded by a two-thirds (2/3) affirmative vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE ELEVEN AMENDMENTS

These Articles of incorporation may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) affirmative vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE TWELVE INDEMNIFICATION

Every Director and every officer of the corporation will be indemnified by the corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including legal fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a party or in which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a Director or an officer of the corporation, whether or not he is a Director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except when the Director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the

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performance of his duties. Provided that, in the event of a settlement this right of indemnification will only apply if a majority of the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interest of the corporation. The foregoing right of indemnification will be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such Director or officer may be entitled.
