ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

a corporation not for profit

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be: ISLAMIC CENTER OF GAINESVILLE, INC., a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of this corporation shall be:

1010 West University Avenue Gainesville, Florida 32601

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The corporation is formed for Religious, Educational and Charitable purposes.

ARTICLE IV - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 931 Wekiva Springs Road, Longwood, Florida 32779 and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address is Emil A. Gasperoni, Jr.

ARTICLE V - INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the Incorporator signing these articles is:

ARTICLE VI - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have three (3) Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors. The number of Directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time as set forth in the Bylaws, but in no event shall be less than three (3).

ARTICLE VII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTIONS

The Board of Directors shall be elected as set forth in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII - OFFICERS

The Officers of this corporation shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The Officers shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors as provided in the by-laws.

The names of the persons who are to serve as such Officers until the first meeting of the Board of Directors are:

ARTICLE X - REVENUE

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, Directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. The corporation shall not in any way, directly or indirectly, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, or participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, by publishing or distributing statements or otherwise. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

ARTICLE XI - MEMBERSHIP

Any muslim may become a member of this corporation upon meeting such other criteria as shall be set forth in the by-laws.

ARTICLE XII - BYLAWS

The Board of Directors of this corporation may provide such by-laws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purpose as it may deem necessary from time to time. Upon proper

notice the by-laws may be amended, altered or rescinded by a two third (2/3) majority vote of members of the entire Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose, and approved by majority (more than 50%) of members of the corporation.

ARTICLE XIII - AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended, altered or rescinded by a two third (2/3) majority vote of members of the entire Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose, and approved by majority (more than 50%) of members of the corporation.

ARTICLE XV - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, The Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
