*In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, relating to corporations not for profit, the undersigned persons do hereby constitute themselves into a non-profit corporation and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation in accordance with said Statute.*

**ARTICLE I    NAME OF ORGANIZATION**

The name of this organization as not for profit corporation shall be **AMVETS POST # 28 OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, INC.**

**ARTICLE II    PURPOSE OF ORGANIZATION**

The general nature and purposes of the corporation so named here shall be:

- a) Fraternal, patriotic, historical and educational; to preserve and strengthen comradeship among its members; to assist worthy comrades; to perpetuate the memory and history of our dead and to assist their widows and orphans, to maintain true allegiance and fidelity to the Constitution of the United States and of the National AMVETS of America and to its By-Laws; to foster true patriotism; to maintain and extend the institutions of American freedom; to preserve and defend the United States from all her enemies, whomsoever.
- b) To take by gift, devise, purchase or in any manner whatsoever, real or personal property, and to sell, transfer, mortgage, lease or rent in any manner whatsoever the same, and to do all things necessary and essential thereto for the benefit of the organization as a not for profit corporation.
- c) To do all things necessary and essential to carry on the activities, rehabilitation, welfare and social work of the Post, including the establishment and operation of the club rooms and other financial operations for the purpose of obtaining the net profits therefrom for the uses and purposes of the Post.

d) The said AMVETS POST # 28 of Hernando County, Florida, Inc. shall at all times remain under the jurisdiction of, and be governed according to the Constitution, By-Laws and Rules of Procedure of the National AMVETS of America. In the event that the provision of these Articles of Incorporation conflicts with the National Charter and By-Laws of the National AMVETS of America, such conflicting provisions shall be deemed null and void, and the National Charter and By-Laws shall, at all times govern.

### ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

The active and voting membership of this corporation shall at all times be confined to the active membership in good standing in AMVETS Post # 28 of Hernando County, Florida, Inc. with eligibility to, acquiring of, suspension from, and discontinuance of membership being in accordance with the National Constitution and By-Laws of the National AMVETS of America.

### ARTICLE IV TERM

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence, subject to the Laws and provisions of the State of Florida and the Constitution and By-Laws of the National AMVETS of America.

In the second case, the method of election or appointment should coincide with the method of selecting its Club or House Committee as to all members except the Officers listed. The statement of Officers applies in all cases. Others may be added if desirable.

## **ARTICLE XI      *MISCELLANEOUS***

In the event of a dissolution of this corporation, all of the assets shall be the property of AMVETS POST # 28 of Hernando County, Florida, Inc. and in the event of the simultaneous dissolution of this corporation and of the forfeiture of the charter issued by National AMVETS of America to said subordinate unit then, and in that event, title to all of the assets of this corporation shall pass to the National AMVETS of America to be disposed of in accordance with the National By-Laws and rules and regulations of the said National AMVETS of America. At no time shall the assets of the corporation be distributed among the individual members thereof.

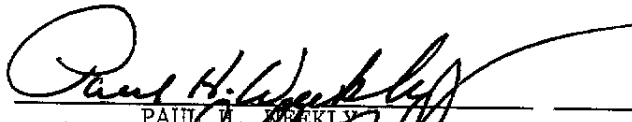


## **ARTICLE XIII      *RECOGNIZING POST AUXILIARY***


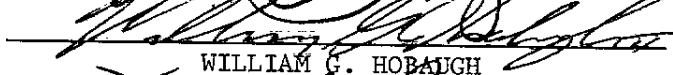

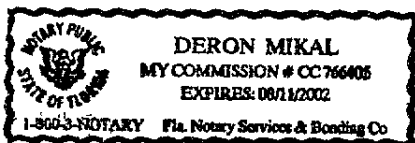

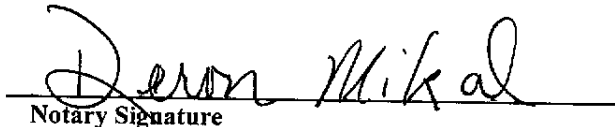
