ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CONCERNED CITIZENS OF SWEETWATER, INC.

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator, desiring to form a corporation not-for-profit pursuant to the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of this corporation is CONCERNED CITIZENS OF SWEETWATER, INC.

ARTICLE II
ADDRESS OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office and street of this corporation is 105 Creekwood Ct., Longwood, FL 32779.

ARTICLE III
INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 105 Creekwood Ct., Longwood, FL 32779 and the name of the registered agent of this corporation at that address is Patricia G. Ahern.

ARTICLE IV

- A. This corporation shall have four (4) directors initially.
- B. The name and address of the initial members of the Board of Directors who shall hold office and elect duly qualified board members and their successors are:

The method of selection of all other Directors shall be as stated in the ByLaws.

ARTICLE V **INCORPORATORS**

ARTICLE VI **INDEMNIFICATION**

This corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE VII **CORPORATE PURPOSES**

One purpose of this not-for-profit corporation shall be to inform and educate the importance of the quality of life in northwest Seminole County and to preserve and protect environmentally sensitive land along the Wekiva River and all other purposes allowed by law.

ARTICLE VIII **QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS**

The method of qualifying members shall be as stated in the ByLaws.

ARTICLE IX **REVENUE**

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, Directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article VII hereof. The corporation shall not in any way, directly or indirectly, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, or participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, by publishing or

distributing statements or otherwise. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

ARTICLE X **DISSOLUTION**

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at that time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VII **BYLAWS**

The Board of Directors of this corporation shall make and adopt Bylaws for the corporation, and said Board and its successors in office shall have power to alter, amend, and/or rescind such Bylaws or to adopt new ByLaws.
