The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida

Not For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I.

NAME

The name of the corporation is José Martí Foundation of Tampa, Inc. (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II.

INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The address of the initial principal office of the Corporation is 3917 Americana Drive,
Tampa, Florida 33634. The mailing address of the Corporation shall be the same.

ARTICLE III.

PURPOSE

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized is to honor and celebrate the life and deeds of José Martí. The Corporation may engage in any and all conduct which it deems necessary or proper to accomplish this purpose, including, among other things, educational efforts, the publication of the works of José Martí, or any other conduct which is intended to honor the life of

José Martí. The Corporation may also engage in such other activities or conduct as not specifically prohibited by the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act. The Corporation shall not take any action which would be contrary to section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended from time to time, and shall comply with the requirements of said code section. No officer, director, person, or entity (except as provided upon dissolution of the Corporation) shall receive any pecuniary gain from the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV.

DIRECTORS

The method of election and removal of the directors of the Corporation is set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V.

MEMBERS ...
