February 17, 2000.


In addition I am enclosing the Association Check # 111 in the

ARTICLE SEVEN is continued:

or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

- e. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, to The Friends of the Library of Hillsborough County, Florida, provided they are still in existence and would qualify for exemption under section 501(c)(3) of the Code. In the event The Friends of the Library of Hillsborough County is not in existence or would fail to qualify for exemption under section 501(c)(3), the Directors shall select another recipient organization which would qualify under section 501 (c)(3) of the Code. Any assets not so distributed shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
